



## National Coalition of "We the People"

Dear Congresswoman Lofgren,

As we informed your staff, we represent the National Coalition of We the People in presenting a fresh, fast, and practical approach to the impeachment issue. It was successfully used in 1973 by a brave group of 87 House members. They were heavily committed to saving the U.S. Constitution and our democracy from President Nixon attempts to establish a unitary executive and destroy the U.S. Constitution.

Yet they did it all without actual impeachment proceedings! You can, too!

This packet contains: 1) a brief summary on why their parliamentary strategy ("The Nixon Flooding plan") should be implemented; and 2) a White Paper detailing, step by step, what those House Democrats did to get both President Nixon and Vice President Spiro Agnew to resign.

Only two participants were not re-elected, but not because of hopping an impeachment bill against Nixon. Republican Paul McCloskey lost to a Democrat; and Bill Roy ran for Senate. Not only did the Democrats control the House in 1973-75 (242-192-1), but they added nearly 50 more members (291-144) three months after Nixon resigned rather than face impeachment.

If constituent feelings ran that high against him, think how high they are right now. Four months ago, the American Research Group poll revealed 52% of Americans believe Cheney has committed impeachable offenses. Your stock among voters will be high, knowing you are a strong supporter of your oath of office to support and defend the U.S. Constitution. □

As noted, an updated version of that plan would have the advantage of satisfying both your conservative and progressive constituents on this troublesome issue. And it would yield quick resignations, beginning with Vice President Cheney. The plan is founded on our concerns that actions are necessary before the next president, and those in the future, take advantage of the precedents set in the "unitary-executive" rule threatening both the Constitution and our democracy.

The plan is a positive compromise that should satisfy all sides of this issue and achieve the aim of stimulating the resignation of both President Bush and his vice president.
